Thank you for your interest in the Art Therapy Internship Program! The Creative Arts Therapy Department at MUSC offers a breadth of expertise in clinically creative interventions, substantiated by ongoing research. Throughout training, interns will gain experience in multiple areas of the health care environment within the context of individual, group, and family therapy. To assist in the transformation to becoming a skilled art therapy professional, on-site supervision will be provided by a board-certified clinical art therapist.

Applications for the MUSC Art Therapy Internship are accepted year-round from individuals enrolled in an Art Therapy graduate program or individuals needing post-graduate hours. Please be aware that we are unable to accept applications that are hand delivered. Upon receipt of completed application package, submissions will be reviewed and selected applicants will be contacted. Prospective interns must be currently enrolled or have graduated from an accredited art therapy master's level program. Candidates will be required to come for a final on-site interview so that he or she can tour the facility and make an informed decision regarding acceptance, if/when internship is offered. Applicants will be notified in writing regarding the status of their application following the on-site interview. Following approval, a legal affiliation will need to be documented with MUSC Health.

Expectations of MUSC Art Therapy Interns

1. All applicants should have the desire to work in a large inpatient and outpatient medical setting, with varied populations.
2. Applicants must be prepared to complete assignments and special projects as outlined in the MUSC internship packet.
3. Accepted applicants must participate in all orientation requirements including, but not limited to, background checks, two-step PPD, drug screen, and vaccination records should be up to date.
4. Applicants are responsible to provide ongoing education about the Art Therapy Program to MUSC Health leaders, physicians, care team members, and the community.
5. Applicants are expected to document and maintain records, progress reports, and statistical information in appropriate formats while also fulfilling the Arts in Healing Program and facility-wide quality assurance/performance improvement standards.
6. Applicants are required to participate in weekly on-site supervision to ensure best practice and continuum of patient care.
